Summary of Function:

Provides assessment, treatment planning and discharge planning for participants in a Counseling Center for probation population. Conducts individual and group counseling and education focusing on intensive alcohol and drug treatment, relapse prevention, aftercare, and cognitive behavioral change. Maintains case files and documentation on all participants, prepares various reports and statistical records, and participates in weekly inter-disciplinary staffing and other meetings as required.

Education and experience equivalent to a Bachelor's degree in social or behavioral science or related field AND two (2) years experience in substance abuse counseling, social services or criminal justice work.
