**a Degree in Criminal Justice**

**Eligibility for Scholarships:**

Current and future women students *accepted* into an accredited college or university, community college, or junior college pursuing a degree in criminal justice.

**Evaluation criteria:**

The scholarship program is open to students attending or planning to attend a college or university, or a junior or community college. Applicants must be accepted into the program.

Scholarships are evaluated according to academic ability, proven dedication to public safety, and financial need.

Scholarship applications are judged by the Board of the Texas Corrections Association. The Board may also utilize independent career professionals to assist in determining the award recipient.

**Application Deadline:**

Applications for the Susan C. Cranford Memorial Scholarship must be postmarked no later than February 1, 2020.
